Ecchinswell Village Pond is looking particularly beautiful this spring. The application of a second batch of weevils has been very effective at removing most of the azolla.

Our annual pond clearance day is set for Sunday 5th October at 9am. If you would like to get involved, full details of timings will follow nearer the time, along with an appeal for volunteers. Boots and gloves are advised. Refreshments will be provided.

The Parish Sustainability Survey will be circulated shortly. It is hoped it will provide a snapshot of the environmental sustainability of our parish in the face of climate change. The answers should inform us on the standards of heating and insulation within our housing, residents plans for electric vehicles, the necessary timescales for increased power supplies, and other initiatives that may reduce the carbon footprint of Ecchinswell, Sydmonton and Bishops Green.
