### Status/Decisions/Actions

1. Record of meeting on 15<sup>th</sup> November agreed – has been put up on NP pages of parish website.
2. SG supports the PC decision to proceed with the NP into Examination without revision. The PC decision followed the public meeting on 14<sup>th</sup> December where there was unanimous support for proceeding by the residents attending. No negatives and some further support has come from the email sent out to residents on 19<sup>th</sup> December. A letter from the PC stating this decision and the rationale has been prepared with advice from B&D BC. This will be attached to a cover letter from B&D BC to the Examiner. SG agreed the text of the letter.
3. Papers covering the LPA comments on the Reg 16 Submission Plan and the representations from statutory consultees and developers were reviewed and our comments agreed by the SG. These papers will also be sent to B&D BC for forwarding to the Examiner. (B&D BC have seen the papers/our comments and agree they are suitable/appropriate.) It was agreed we do not see a need for Jon Dowty to review our comments as the issues raised are relatively minor and there would be a charge at the high rate. We expect our next use of his services will be for review of the Examiners Report.
4. It is expected we will receive some questions/comments from the Examiner during her review of the plan but timing of these is uncertain (January into early Feb). If they are relatively minor, it was agreed they would be circulated to SG members by email with a suggested response – SG members are asked to respond with comments/support as soon as practicable. In the event there is something more major, an SG meeting will be called. Otherwise we envisage the next SG meeting will be to review the Examiners Report...likely in early/mid-February.
