Status/Decisions/Actions

- Record of the last meeting on 1st Feb (<u>1st February 2022</u> (<u>Web view</u>)) was agreed and has been uploaded to the NP pages of the PC website
- 2. Project risks were briefly reviewed with no new risk areas perceived but several continuing to need monitoring/attention (Working Risk Matrix (Web view))
- 3. Most items on the action Log (<u>Action Log</u> (<u>Web view</u>)) are progressing with the main focus being on the Call for Sites and development of early draft policies and supporting evidence.
- 4. Finance. The cycle for return of unspent funds and application/approval of new funds had been successfully completed and we have the money required for our planned spend in March. Locality funding for 2022/23 is not yet assured so we are not clear that we will have support from them for spend on oneil-homer consultant. The SEA and Design Code work is however fully approved and canl progress to completion.
- 5. Call for Sites. The "long-list" outcome of the Call for Sites process was reviewed with a go-forward long list agreed for discussion with oneil-homer on 3rd March and progression into the site specific SEA work. A number of key points were discussed including the risks around our desire to progress our plan to completion before the B&D BC Local Plan Update is "made". John will find opportunity to review this topic with Gill/Simon so they are fully up to date and given their inputs.
- 6. AECOM have produced the scoping report in a timely way and that is now out for review with the Environment Agency and Historic/Natural England with completion due at end of March. We now have an identified person from AECOM to execute the Design Code work.

- 7. The 23rd February "check-in" on the workplan showed some good progress but a lot more to be done. We will have discussion with oneil-homer in early March to determine whether the early draft policies and evidence are suitable start points for them to help us develop the full policies/support material.
- 8. Limited new insight into the B&D BC LPU except that we are not likely to get any further input on the allocation process for rural communities until June. Most focus is currently on the overall B&D BC target and the challenges around the proposed allocation to Tadley both of which might trigger a revisit of the indicative allocation we have received.
- 9. Business and Stakeholder engagement will resume once the Call for Sites work has subsided. We had a useful meeting with Sovereign Housing.
- 10. No new development news the Catesby Estates and Hathor Properties applications are still in play.
