Status/Decisions/Actions

- 1. Record of meeting on 10th May agreed will be put up on parish website
- 2. Risk review. Two new risks added to the Project Risk Log:
 - Loss of our liaison officer in B&D BC planning (Robyn Milliner who has resigned to go to the
 private sector no replacement yet identified this could delay progressing the Reg 14/16
 stages of our plan and hence the overall timing rated as RED
 - Delayed delivery of AECOM Design Codes potentially 3 weeks behind extend timing of early
 June this could affect progression to Reg 14 submission targets for end July rated as Orange
 - Marian owns both and will work with B&D BC/AECOM to mitigate.
- 3. Action Log a number of updates noted action need to review selection of Key Views tabled Charles/Simon/Marian will work this.
- 4. Finance we are funded for the project delivery some review/action on VAT recoveries required Charles to liaise with Sarah J (Parish Clerk)
- 5. Follow up from Community Consultation
 - Analysis of feedback reviewed no further comments overall direction and key components
 have good support and our total of 119 respondents or 10% of the adult population is seen as
 good for this kind of event with a wide spread of attendees
 - Communication to the community agreed will be posted on website and distributed via email.

 - i. The Consultation review section needs minor updates.
 - ii. The Site Sustainability Assessment by AECOM was reviewed/recognised
 - iii. The proposed way forward on Bishops Green Site Selection was agreed
 - iv. The proposed way forward on Ecchinswell Site Selection was agreed with a minor addition of seeking some green space
 - v. The proposed way forward on Settlement Boundaries was agreed
 - vi. Some rework of the proposals on Housing Mix were discussed/agreed
- Next steps are working the actions from the discussion paper and taking the analysis/feedback into drafting of the plan document for Reg 14 Pre-Submission Consultation.
- 6. Evolution of thinking on the B&D BC LPU and its impact on housing allocation discussed await decisions form the EPH meeting on 9th June. We have a formal letter from B&D BC confirming our allocation and Marian is seeking an amended version with some extra wording recommended by Jon Dowty that should improve the robustness of our plan.
- 7. Roadmap to Reg 14 Consultation objective of reaching this by end July is tight given delayed delivery of the AECOM Design Codes and the absence of B&D BC liaison contact. We will however drive for minimal delay.
- 8. AECOM delivery update:
 - Post consultation scoping report awaited
 - Site Assessment final report with minor corrections awaited
 - Design Codes 3 week delay as noted
 - Marian chasing these
- 9. No new development news timing of review of Catesby/Hathor applications remains uncertain but not seen as imminent given delivery of responses from official bodies and low resources in B&D BC Planning.
