- 8. Hydes Platt, North Sydmonton (Outside Hope Cottage)

<u>Duration of Order:</u> The order will come into effect on 17 October 2016 for 1 Year. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected each road closure will be for 3 days only (advance warning signs will be displayed)
