Good news - Ecchinswell, is at last going to have the railings on its bridge over the stream repaired. Basingstoke and Deane have suggested a date of 7th November, although this could be put back if circumstances change.

Another bit of happy news is the planting of a beautiful tree in the fields at Ecchinswell Village Hall. This is in commemoration of the Platinum Jubilee of the late Queen. It is a Corpus Mallus Scarlet which blossoms in Spring, flowers during the Summer and has gorgeous Autumn foliage, hopefully to be enjoyed by all.

Lastly, we had 2 officers join us for the October Parish Council meeting. They are part of the Basingstoke and Deane community safety patrol team and are instrumental in dealing with anti-social behaviour. Interestingly they have had some positive feedback on dealing with some very young offenders in the area, which gives great hope for the future. Most of us did not know that "petty crimes" should be reported to them and not the police.
